



## WFSC Skater Activities Code of Conduct

Updated: October 2022

RE: WFSC Skater/Student and Parents

Students who participate in figure skating are required to conduct themselves with respect for self and others through their actions, language and dress.

Students who chose to participate in the Watertown Figure Skate Club represent their community and school at public events and performances.

Student participants are expected to demonstrate year around behavior that reflects positively on the individual, the school and the community.

Students (still enrolled in school and under the age of 18) wishing to participate in activities sponsored or recognized by the Watertown Figure Skate Club and the following school districts, but not limited to, - Watertown, Florence, Henry, Waverly/South Shore, Deuel, Sisseton, Webster, Great Plains Lutheran, any other school district in the US or any homeschooled student – shall:

- Not use or possess alcoholic beverages regardless of percentage of content
- Not use or possess any drug or narcotic not prescribed by a physician to the student,
- Not use or possess any controlled substance
- Not use or possess tobacco and nicotine products, vapes or any electronic delivery system device
- Not behave in any manner that will bring discredit to the student's team and school, including breaking and/or being convicted of petty offense/Class 2 crimes (i.e.: vandalism, open container)
- Shall maintain a minimum of 2.0 GPA or will be deemed ineligible for one week

Note: This policy does not apply to consumption of legal drugs prescribed for the student by a physician.

This policy is in effect on or off ice, in vehicles/buses or at events.

The penalties for training rule violation(s) will be a zero-tolerance policy for drug offenses and will cause for the athlete to be eliminated for the remainder of the season. All other first-time offenses will result in a one week suspension of all WFSC activities. Second time offenders will be eliminated for the remainder of the season.

Training rules and consequences apply to WFSC skaters "in season" (dates vary depending on exact start and end date of season)
